The Department of Anthropology and the Southeast Asia Community Resource Center present this exhibition of Hmong history and culture. The Sacramento Hmong community has constructed a Hmong house and outbuildings in the museum. The house interior is equipped for life in highland Laos. The Hmong community has loaned clothing, shaman equipment, and farm tools for display.

Twenty panels depicting Hmong history from China to Sacramento were provided as part of a National Endowment for the Humanities grant through the Chippewa Valley Muweum in Eau Claire Wisconsin.
