major expenditures were for website contract labor, webhosting, postage, software, and taxes.

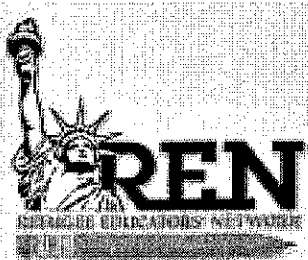
- d. ACTION: Approve 2004-05 Budget, as revised. Moved by Peter Whittlesey, seconded by Lue Vang, unanimously approved.

Projecting \$5,000 in REN book sales, the expenditures for 2004-05 will be website labor (\$5,000), webhosting fees (\$1,000), taxes and prep (\$500), subscriptions (\$300), postage and supplies (\$300), California School Librarian Assn exhibitor fee to encourage donations for book box libraries for Laos (\$700), and co-sponsoring conference with California International Studies Project, Sacramento City USD, FCUSD, and Grant Joint Union SD to increase understanding and knowledge about immigrants. The undesignated amount is \$8,296 (if \$5,000 in sales is realized).

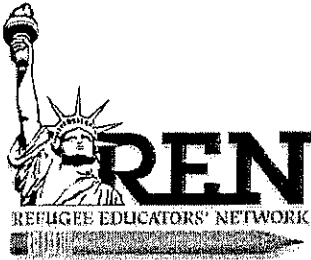

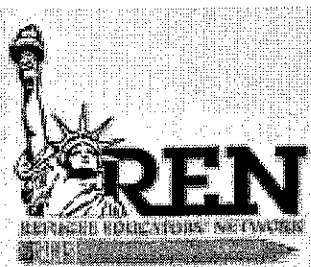
