•SEACRC has had 3 sources of support: Folsom Cordova; CDE; and the conference operated by the Network. The state support through the Emergency Immigrant Education Program will end 9/30/97. For good this time; there was an audit exception. The \$26,000 subgrant provided a small but critical part of the support of the Center (the clerk, 25% of the phone, materials, supplies) so that we could tell our own district people that none of the funds for students were being used for resources for teachers and community members outside our boundaries. We need to discuss options make decisions (ACTION):

- SEACRC closed after 9/1/97? (layoff).
- SEACRC open, no checkouts, no new materials. (layoff).
- Halt time-consuming phone & personal assistance to other districts, community members, college students about Hmong, SEAsians, other refugees & immigrants.
- No Immigrant Faire; IEF with raised fees, enough to pay clerical?
- Share the cost of the clerk among districts?
